


GLACIER VIEW RANCH

Professional Counselors - Sign-up sheets will be available during the retreat weekend for you to meet with a counselor.


Veggie Foods - Wanda Hart will have a table in the outer auditorium foyer for you to buy or place orders for vegetarian foods.
